Introduction

- Organization is a <u>consciously</u> <u>coordinated social unit</u> composed of <u>two or more people</u> that <u>functions on</u> <u>relatively continuous basis</u> to achieve a <u>common goal</u>.
- OB is specifically concerned with <u>work-related behavior</u> that takes place in an organization.

organizational behavior (0B)

A field of study that investigates the impact that individuals, groups, and structure have on behavior within organizations, for the purpose of applying such knowledge toward improving an organization's effectiveness.

Importance of OB

 Helps manager to <u>understand why people behave</u> in certain way as their behavior may <u>affect the productivity</u>.

 Managers should have the capacity <u>to predict</u> which employee is dedicated & productive or which one might be absent, disruptive on certain days (so that manager can <u>take preventive decisions</u>).

Aim of OB is to control and develop human activity at work.
